ABDULLAH FLAGS OFF PEACE MALAYSIA MOTORISED CONVOY

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 9 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi flagged off the Malaysian Peoples Peace Alliance (Peace Malaysia) motorised convoy, which will tour Peninsula Malaysia, at the Putra World Trade Centre here today.

The convoy, comprising 111 participants on 67 motorcycles and 14 cars, will travel to Perlis, Penang, Kedah, Perak and Selangor before returning to the Merdeka Square here on Sunday.

The Motorised Peace Programme, which started in Sabah on Oct 4 before moving to Sarawak the next day, aims to spread Peace Malaysia's message and get public endorsement of its Second Peace Memorandum.

The memorandum is scheduled to be handed over to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and the Organisation of Islamic Conference Summit delegates.
