NAM: MORE LEADERS CALL ON DR MAHATHIR

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 25 (Bernama) -- More leaders attending the 13th Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) Summit called on Malaysian Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today, the last day of the summit.

In the afternoon, Mali President Amadou Toumani headed the long list of leaders who called on Dr Mahathir at Putra World Trade Centre (PWTC), the venue of the six-day summit.

Others were Personal Envoy of the Emir of Kuwait, Sheikh Sabah Al Ahmad Al Jabar Al Sabah, Sudan Vice-President Ali Othman Mohammed Taha and Mauritius Prime Minister Sir Anerood Jugnauth.
