NAM: M'SIA CAN STEER NAM TO A WAR-FREE FUTURE

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 24 (Bernama) -- The Asian Group of the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) is confident that Malaysia will steer the movement towards a future that is free from war, disputes, poverty and diseases.

Speaking on behalf of the group at the opening of the 13th NAM Summit here today, head of the Kuwaiti delegation, Sheikh Sabah Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah said this could only be achieved by reforming and revitalising the movement's approaches.
