NO CABINET APPOINTMENTS, NO RESHUFFLE, SAYS ABDULLAH

PUTRAJAYA, Nov 5 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi said today that there will not be any Cabinet appointments or a reshuffle at the moment.

He told reporters this after chairing his first weekly Cabinet meeting after being sworn in as Malaysia's fifth Prime Minister last Friday.

Abdullah also said that he had assumed the post of Finance Minister held by his predecessor, Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad, who stepped down as Prime Minister after leading the country for 22 years.

Abdullah said that he would be attending a briefing at the Treasury next Tuesday.
