NOBEL LAUREATES INVITED TO THE LAUNCH OF WORLD CLASS R&D LABORATORY

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 8 (Bernama) -- Nobel laureates, internationally recognised scientists and senior industrialists are among 1,000 guests invited to the official launch of InventQjaya (IQJ) at Cyberjaya on Saturday by Prime Minister, Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad

IQJ, a world class R&D laboratory, said in a statement that its objective was to become a leading research centre for cutting edge frontier technologies by producing record numbers of inventions, patent and "spin out" companies.

IQJ also encourages Malaysian scientists working abroad to return home and join it in its mission to turn Malaysians into great investors while maintaining local values.

A government-backed venture with Reveo of USA, this invention-oriented advanced science laboratory has been funded specially to help ensure the success of Malaysia's Vision 2020.

IQJ is a progression from its "fast track" laboratory launched by Dr Mahathir and Reveo in January this year, which was intended to demonstrate Reveo's ability and credibility during the construction of its permanent facilities.

Chairman and chief executive officer of IQJ, Dr Faris said using Reveo's revolutionary "InventQbation" process, IQJ would invent, discover and innovate new global industries that would become the dominant corporations for Malaysia's future knowledge economy.
