PAHANG BN YOUTH PLEDGES WIN AS "RETIREMENT GIFT" FOR DR MAHATHIR

TEMERLOH, Oct 30 (Bernama) -- The Pahang Barisan Nasional (BN) Youth pledged victory for all of BN candidates in the next general elections as a "retirement" gift for Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Its chief, Ismail Mohamed Said, said the BN Youth would mobilise all of its machineries and cooperate with the Wanita BN to achieve this objective.

"We will have speakers to attack the opposition's strongholds. Based on the current political scenario, we are confident that the BN will be able to wrest back the seats it "lent" the opposition (in the last general elections)," he said here today.
