PALESTINIAN ISSUE HELMS OF AMAN MSIA CONFERENCE

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 10 (Bernama) -- The Palestinian tragedy, arms issue, and disasters in Iraq are the main topics of discussion at the Aman Malaysia conference organised by the People's Alliance for Peace this Sunday.

The one day conference would be divided into three sessions involving the presentation of working papers by local and foreign panelists.

Its chairman Dr Shamsul Anuar said the conference would formulate a resolution from four conferences and forums held earlier.

"This conference will formulate the resolution before creating a draft memorandum to be presented to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad," Dr Shamsul told reporters here today.

The Aman Malaysia One Million Signatures campaign, jointly organised by the Pertubuhan Belia 4B and the Malaysian Association of Youth Clubs, in protest against the United States' attack on Iraq and for the Palestinian liberation issue.

Dr Shamsul said 1,000 people - students, non-governmental organisations and the public - would participate in the conference. And 20 per cent of the participants were foreign students living here.

Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi was expected to launch the event while Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Syed Hamid Albar would attend the closing ceremony.

Five panelists would table their working papers - International Movement for a Just World (Malaysia) president Dr Chandra Muzaffa; Khan Uni City Mayor Osama al-Farra, and the Legal Adviser to the Palestinian Liberations movement Michael Tarazi.

The event would be held at the Mandarin Oriental hotel and entry was free to for the public.

Meanwhile, teenage singing-sensation "7 Sequal" would sing "It is a small World" and "No matter What" in acapella tune at the conference.
