PBS FULLY SUPPORTS PM'S INSTRUCTION TO BE TRUTHFUL

KOTA KINABALU, Nov 10 (Bernama) -- Parti Bersatu Sabah (PBS) has expressed its full support to the call by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi to all Barisan Nasional (BN) members to be truthful in dealing with the people's problems.

Its Secretary-General, Datuk Radin Malleh, said PBS would give the Prime Minister all the cooperation he needed.

"PBS would like to put on record that we will give full and solid support to the Prime Minister's stand on the issue of good quality leadership, minimising bureaucracy and eliminating corruption in the Government," he said in a statement today.
