PERAK PROPERTY EXPO HAS PROPERTIES WORTH RM705 MLN ON OFFER

IPOH, May 26 (Bernama) -- A total of 6,123 units of property worth RM705 million will be offered during the two-day Perak Real Estate Expo (Ekspo Hartanah Perak) here beginning Friday at the Indera Mulia Stadium.

The Real Estate and Housing Developers' Association of Malaysia's (Rehda) Perak branch chairman, Datuk Francis Lee, said these include various types of houses, industrial and agricultural lots, offices and shops.

The biggest number of properties available would be the 1,507 single storey terrace houses, followed by 1,119 of bungalow and agricultural lots and 985 units of double storey terrace house.

Other properties are single storey low-cost houses (569), single storey semi-detached houses (258), single storey bungalows (46), one and half storey terrace houses (93), double storey-semi detached houses (197), double storey bungalows (93), two and half storey terrace houses (46) and 19 three-storey terrace houses.

Also available are 459 shophouse/shopoffice, 666 units of apartments and condominium and 32 industrial lots.

The event is jointly organised by Ipoh City Hall, the Perak State Development Corporation and Rehda.

Lee said the expo was also timely as it would be held just a week after Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had announced a strategic economic package to stimulate the domestic economy.

"Since the various incentives are only for a limited period intended to stimulate domestic economic activities, homebuyers should take advantage of the incentives provided," Lee added. -- BERNAMA
