POS MALAYSIA TO ISSUE 13TH NAM SUMMIT COMMEMORATIVE STAMPS

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 1 (Bernama) -- Stamps collectors will have the opportunity to increase their collections when Pos Malaysia Bhd issues its commemorative stamps in conjunction with the 13th Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) Summit here from Feb 20 to 25.

Pos Malaysia's Stamps and Philately Division Manager Che Soh Che Awang said the NAM Summit is a historic and important event for Malaysia.

The commemorative stamps will help to introduce the summit, which will be held for the first time in Malaysia, he told Bernama.

"Important events which take place in the country could be immortalised on postage stamps. So the international community, and also our people to remember, will remember Malaysia as the host country.

"These events will enhance Malaysia's image in the eyes of the world," he said.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will launch the stamps and First Day covers for the NAM Summit on Feb 6, together with commemorative coin and a book on Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCP).

The NAM stamps will be available in 30 sen and 50 sen while the First Day cover will be sold at RM1.90 a piece.

Che Soh said the stamps and First Day covers would be available at all post offices from Feb 6.

Malaysia will also issue commemorative stamps for the Organisation of Islamic Conference (OIC) meeting here in October.
