SECURITY MATTERS DISCUSSED AT MEETING OF CONFERENCE OF RULERS

KUALA LUMPUR, June 26 (Bernama) -- Matters concerning security were among the agendas at the 197th meeting of the Conference of Rulers, which concluded today.

The two-day meeting at the Istana Negara also discussed religious matters and appointments, according to a statement from the Office of the Keeper of the Rulers' Seal, Conference of Malaysian Rulers.

Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin Syed Putra Jamalulail, who was accompanied by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, attended the meeting today.

All the Rulers were present except for the Sultan of Perak who was represented by the Regent of Perak, Raja Dr Nazrin Shah, and the Sultan of Johor, who was represented by Tunku Mahkota Johor, Tunku Ibrahim Ismail.

All the Yang Dipertua Negeri also attended the meeting.

The meeting was chaired by Yang Dipertuan Besar Negeri Sembilan, Tuanku Ja'afar Ibni Almarhum Tuanku Abdul Rahman.
