SELANGOR GERAKAN DECLARES FULL SUPPORT FOR ABDULLAH

KLANG, July 20 (Bernama) -- Selangor Gerakan today declared full support for Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi as the new incoming Prime Minister and Barisan Nasional Chairman.

In its 11-point Declaration adopted at the end of its Delegates Conference here, Selangor Gerakan also expressed its sincere thanks to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad for his outstanding leadership of the country over the last 22 years.

The 350-odd delegates representing divisions and branches in Selangor handed over the Declaration to State Gerakan Chairman Datuk Lum Weng Keong.
