MAHATHIR TO OFFICIATE PBS CONGRESS IN SABAH ON SEPT 8

KOTA KINABALU, Aug 15 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad is expected to open the 18th Annual Delegates Conference of Parti Bersatu Sabah (PBS) at the Hongkod Koisaan Hall, near here, on Sept 8.

PBS Secretary-General Datuk Radin Malleh said apart from senior Barisan Nasional (BN) leaders in Sabah, the party was also inviting leaders of BN component parties from Peninsular Malaysia and Sarawak.

Radin said the AGM would be a three-day affair where elections to the party's Supreme Council, Youth and Wanita Executive Committees would also be held.

"The delegates conference this year is very special in that it would be the last one to be officiated by the Prime Minister in his capacity as the BN chairman.

"We are already in the final stages of preparation and expect a 5,000-strong crowd of PBS members and supporters to welcome the Prime Minister," he said in a statement here today.

In conjunction with the AGM, the party would be publishing a 200-page souvenir book, a special edition of Suara Bersatu and stage a photo exhibition featuring PBS activities in the last 18 years, he said.

Radin said several resolutions on politics, economy, education, land and labour from PBS divisions might be tabled and debated by the delegates during the conference.
