SRAM GETS RM1 MILLION ALLOCATION

PETALING JAYA, Aug 22 (Bernama) -- The Squash Rackets Association of Malaysia (SRAM) received a windfall tonight when they were awarded a RM1 million allocation by the Malaysian Totalisator Board for their activities.
