SYED RAZAK SUGGESTS DR M FOR KEDAH BN ELECTIONS ADVISOR

ALOR STAR, Sept 5 (Bernama) -- Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Syed Razak Syed Zain has suggested that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad be appointed Kedah Barisan Nasional (BN) advisor for the upcoming general elections.

He said the matter would be brought up at the next State Liaison Committee and BN meetings before it was presented to Dr Mahathir for his agreement upon his retirement next month.

"Dr Mahathir has a strong influence in this State apart from being highly respected and we are confident he can make a huge contribution to ensure BN's victory here," he told reporters after opening the "Struggle, Unity and Friendship Carnival" organised by the Kuala Kedah Puteri Umno, here today.
