WEST SUMATRA GOVERNOR ON NEGERI SEMBILAN HONOURS LIST

SEREMBAN, July 18 (Bernama) -- West Sumatra Governor H.Sutan Zainal Bakar and former Felda chairman Raja Tan Sri Muhammad Alias Raja Mohamed Ali head the list of 884 people awarded honours in conjunction with the 81st birthday of the Yang Dipertuan Besar of Negeri Sembilan Tuanku Ja'afar tomorrow.
