

Stamping its presence after 20 years

PUTRAJAYA: Philatelists have another set of commemorative stamps to add to their collection – the Proton Gen-2 special stamps to mark Proton's 20th anniversary.

Former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad, who is Proton adviser, launched the stamps that come in three denominations – 30sen, 50sen and RM1 – at the Perdana Leadership Foundation here

yesterday.

The stamps are also available on a first-day cover, a RM4 presentation pack and a RM3 stamp booklet.

Pos Malaysia has started selling the stamps since March 7 and so far about RM100,000 worth of stamps have been sold.

Energy, Water and Communications Minister Datuk Seri Dr. Lim Keng Yaik said the

stamps were the third batch of commemorative stamps for Proton. The first was when Proton was launched and the second was in 1995 when a stamp booklet was issued on Proton cars.

Also present were Proton group chief executive officer Tengku Tan Sri Mahaleel Tengku Ariff and Pos Malaysia Berhad chairman Datuk Abdul Majid Hussein.
