BARISAN NASIONAL GOVT GIVES RM3.45 MILLION TO POOR STUDENTS

BAHAU, Jan 25 (Bernama) -- The Negeri Sembilan Barisan Nasional Government has allocated RM3.45 million in aid to poor students in the state this year.

Menteri Besar Tan Sri Mohamed Isa Abdul Samad said the aid would benefit some 30,000 poor students in various kampungs, new villages and estates in Negeri Sembilan.

"This aid clearly shows how concerned the Barisan Nasional Government is over the plight of the poor and is always trying to help them," he said.

Tan Sri Mohamed Isa was launching the Chinese New Year celebrations in the Sungai Lui state constituency here last night.

"This aid is being given irrespective of the political affiliations of the people," he said.
