DR MAHATHIR LAUNCHES PUSTAKA PERDANA

PUTRAJAYA, April 29 (Bernama) -- Former Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad today launched the "Pustaka Perdana", a digital library containing heritage materials on Malaysia's four prime ministers, including himself.

The library in Presinct 8, here, which is a project under Yayasan Kepimpinan Perdana, is expected to gather books, records, speeches, policy papers and newspaper cuttings regarding the four leaders.

Meanwhile, Putrajaya Corporation president Tan Sri Azizan Zainul Abidin, who is also the foundation chairman, said: "The library will be developed into the ultimate resource centre to record the political, social and economic struggles faced by the leaders".

Membership is open to all individuals aged 18 and above.
