IMBI ROAD EXPRESS BUS TERMINAL OPERATIONAL FROM JAN 15

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 12 (Bernama) --The new RM1 million Imbi road express bus terminal will be operational from Jan 15, Chairman of the Commercial Vehicle Licensing board Datuk Raja Ahmad Zainuddin Raja Omar said today.

Express buses to destinations in Peninsular Malaysia and Singapore would use the terminal which is located in Pasar Rakyat which was opened by former Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad in January 2002.

Intrakota Sdn Bhd and Putra Liner would also pick up and drop passengers at the terminal, Raja Ahmad said after inspecting the Bus Terminal.

Express bus companies -- Transnasional, Park May, Nice and Gunung Raya Express would also use the terminal, he said.

The new terminal would complement the services provided at other bus stations such as Puduraya, Hentian Putra and Jalan Duta terminal.

He said the Imbi road terminal had 18 bus bays but could be increased to 100 bays.

Taxis using coupons would also operate from the terminal.

The bus companies have 60 counters at the terminal selling tickets to various destinations.
