INVENTQJAYA CAREER FAIR 2004 IN CYBERJAYA SATURDAY

KUALA LUMPUR, March 23 (Bernama) -- InventQjaya Sdn Bhd will organise a career fair in Cyberjaya this Saturday for Malaysians who are keen to make contributions to the development of science and technology in the country.
