OPCOM CLINCHES CONTRACT TO SUPPLY FIBRE OPTIC CABLES WORTH RM171.4
MILLION

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 10 (Bernama) -- OPCOM Holdings Bhd has entered into a supply agreement worth RM171.4 million with its subsidiary, Opcom Sdn Bhd (OSB), to manufacture and supply fibre optic cables to OSB's customer, Telekom Malaysia Bhd.

The supply mandate constitutes about 80 percent of a new three-year supply contract worth RM214.2 million which OSB had signed with Telekom on Feb 7, 2004, the company said in a statement here today.

OPCOM Holdings, established in 1994, is a leading maker of fibre optic cable with its manufacturing facility in Shah Alam.

Meanwhile, OSB president Datuk Mukhriz Mahathir said, "OSB has almost 10 years of stellar track record with Telekom and our continued success is a strong reflection of Telekom's commitment to nurture and help build results-driven bumiputera businesses in the high technology sector."

As for OPCOM, the statement said the supply mandate bodes well for the group in the coming years as it will be able to continue to be the industry leader as well as being the largest supplier of fiber optic cables to Telekom. -- BERNAMA
