KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 15 (Bernama) -- The Sepang International Circuit (SIC) is offering a RM50 discount on the three-day Hillstand C2 ticket for the F1 Malaysian GP during the Racers United in Aid of Tsunami Fund Campaign at the circuit tomorrow.

SIC Press Officer Azhar Ghazali said visitors can purchase the tickets, discounted from the normal price of RM250, at pit 19 on the pit lane from 10am.
