Dr M: I'm not paid as adviser

LANGKAWI, Thurs. - Former Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad said today he is not getting even one sen from being adviser to Petronas, Proton, the Langkawi Development Authority (Lada) and Tioman Development Authority.

He said that he only received the pension for serving as Prime Minister for more than 22 years.

"I wish to explain that I am not getting even a single sen from being the adviser to Petronas, Proton, Lada and Tioman. I only have an office provided by Petronas," he said when opening the Dialogue 2010 at the Langkawi Lagoon Resort here.

Dr Mahathir said he needed to explain the situation as there had been talk he was receiving allowances from being the adviser to these companies and agencies.
