Haron sure of support in Perlis

KUALA LUMPUR, Mon. - Pas information chief Datuk Dr Haron Din is still hoping to contest a seat in his home State of Perlis as it would guarantee him firm support.

He said he believed he has a better chance of winning in Perlis due to the number of his supporters there.

"If they put me in another state like Terengganu for example, the sentiment is different than in a place where you have your friends and family," he said.

Haron said where he would be contesting would depend on the party's political committee which decides on seat allocations.

"The party will make the decision after Parliament is dissolved," he said after a dialogue on Pas' Islamic State document today.

Haron was widely tipped to be the Pas candidate against former Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad for Kubang Pasu in the 1999 general election but he did not contest.
