Go cast your vote first, then watch the race, F1 fans urged

KUALA LUMPUR, Fri. - Transport Minister Datuk Seri Chan Kong Choy today reminded voters to perform their responsibility by casting their votes on polling day before proceeding to watch the Petronas Malaysian Grand Prix this Sunday.

"I urge voters who are F1 fans to vote first. After that, you are all clear to watch the race," he told reporters when visiting the Flood Mitigation Project in Kampung Kepong Ulu here today.

The Petronas Malaysian Grand Prix - the second leg of the 2004 Formula One Championship season - will be held on March 21 - Malaysia's polling day.

Chairman of Sepang International Circuit, Datuk Mokhzani Mahathir, said F1 fans had ample time to vote as the race proper only begins at 3pm.
