Siti seeks advice from Dr Mahathir

PUTRAJAYA, Mon. - The country's top singer, Siti Nurhaliza, today took time off from her busy schedule to seek advice from former Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad and wife, Tun Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali, on her April concert at the Royal Albert Hall in London.
