A unique city

DISCOVER a truly unique city that lies in the heart of Malaysia where man, nature and technology co-exist in harmony. Featuring the most advanced Information Technology (IT) infrastructure and facilities in a city surrounded by lush tropical greenery, Cyberjaya stands at the forefront of world-class 21st-century living.

Hailed as Malaysia's first intelligent city, the 7,000-hectare Cyberjaya was designed and built to be the home ground of international IT firms, much like the Silicon Valley in the United States.

Cyberjaya was envisioned by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad as the nucleus of a Multimedia Super Corridor (MSC) in Malaysia, a 750-square-kilometre stretch of land that stretches from the KL City Centre to the KL International Airport (KLIA) in Sepang.

Cyberjaya's prime district is known as the Flagship Zone, a 2,890-hectare plot of land that is currently being developed as a self-contained intelligent city dedicated to offering a premier business and living environment. It covers three specialised zones - commercial, enterprise and residential.

The development of the whole Flagship Zone is being carried out in two phases - to be completed by 2006 and 2011 respectively. Upon completion, the city will be equipped with a city-wide network of interactive broadband services, offering all areas within the zone quick and ready access to the internet.
