PJ Hilton offers wireless broadband service

PETALING Jaya Hilton, in partnership with wireless broadband provider Airzed Networks Sdn Bhd, has announced the launch of their wireless broadband service.

The joint venture now makes PJ Hilton one of the country's first five-star business hotels to offer total wireless broadband Internet service.

Michael Nagel, the hotel's general manager, said the first phase of the wireless broadband installation has already been completed. The second phase is currently in progress and scheduled to be completed in July, followed by phase three, which is due in September.

"For Airzed to successfully provide coverage throughout the 150,000 square feet in this hotel bodes well for our ability as a wholly-owned Malaysian company to handle broadband end-to-end solutions to homes, businesses and university campuses," said Airzed Network's executive chairman Mukhriz Mahathir.

During the briefing, Computimes had the chance to test the quality of the wireless connection. The connectivity can be considered good while the signal strength is excellent. The Airzed prepaid cards are available in denominations of two hours for RM40, five hours for RM60, 24 hours for RM100 and 48 hours for RM180.
