Continue education policies set in Dr M's era, says Isa

SEREMBAN, Sun. - Policies on education set in the era of Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad should be continued and developed for the continued success of the nation.

Menteri Besar Tan Sri Mohd Isa Abdul Samad said the policies, notably the teaching of Mathematics and Science in English, should be continued as it would benefit future generations.

Speaking after opening Sekolah Kebangsaan Datuk Klana Maamor's new computer laboratory, he said advances in education had brought much progress to the country.

"To sustain this continued progress, we must continue with the policies set in place by the previous administration," he said.
