Dr M: I'm willing to be adviser to Petronas

ALOR STAR, Fri. - Former Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad today said he does not see any problem in taking up the post as adviser to Petronas if offered.

"As an adviser, yes I can. (Former Prime Minister) Tun Hussein Onn was also an adviser," Dr Mahathir said at the Sultan Abdul Halim airport before leaving for Kuala Lumpur.

He, however, said he was unaware of any such offer. "I have not received any letter. I will check on it when I get back."

Dr Mahathir, who is also Kubang Pasu Member of Parliament, was here on a two-day visit to Kedah.

It is understood that Dr Mahathir, who retired on Oct 31, has been appointed to the post.
