Felcra also keen to go for listing on KLSE

KOTA BARU, Sat. - Felcra Berhad is ready to follow in the footsteps of Felda and go for listing on the Kuala Lumpur Stock Exchange (KLSE), Felcra chairman Datuk Hamzah Zainuddin said.

It would be easier for Felcra to be listed as it was already a corporate body, owned by the Government. "But it is up to the Government to decide," he said after closing the Kelantan Felcra Family Day at the PCB Resort here today.

The move to have Felda listed on the KLSE was announced by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad when tabling the Budget 2004 in Parliament recently.
