National Library gets books from institute

"INSPIRATION and creativity go hand in hand. Without inspiration, incredible results would not be forthcoming. Likewise, without creativity, there would be no excitement and passion translated into work."

These words came from LimKokWing Institute of Creative Technology governing council chairman Tan Sri Dr Awang Had Salleh, who was speaking at a ceremony to hand over books from the institute to the National Library recently.

A total of 5,200 copies of Inspiring Moments and 14 copies of Wings of Creativity was presented to National Library director-general Datuk Zawiyah Baba.

Also present were Penang Public Library Corporation director Ong Chai Lin, Perak Public Library Corporation director Mohd Taib Mohamed, Pahang Public Library Corporation director Ismail Mutalib and Pustaka Negeri Sarawak chief executive officer Rashidah Bolhassan.

Awang Had said the contribution aimed at motivating the younger generation to read more, in line with the Government's efforts to upgrade the proficiency of English language among students and youths.

The Wings of Creativity, put together by Tan Sri Lim Kok Wing, reflects the fast-paced progress achieved by the country in the past 20 years under the leadership of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

The book also highlights the practical and effective applications of creativity to the Malaysian industry as well as sports promotions, government campaigns and charities.

The other book, Inspiring Moments, was penned by a group of the institute's mass communications students (class of 2001).
