Gerakan launches exhibition on Vision 2020

GERAKAN president Datuk Seri Dr Lim Keng Yaik yesterday launched an exhibition on Vision 2020 in conjunction with the party's annual National Delegates' Conference.

The exhibition paid tribute to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad who outlined the Vision in 1991. Dr Mahathir, due to retire in October, will open the conference for the last time today.

"Vision 2020 is used as a guide for Gerakan. If a party does not have a vision, then the party will go no-where," said Dr Lim who is also Primary Industries Minister, in his launching speech.

Dr Lim said Vision 2020 was in line with the party's non-racial approach and was a unifying factor for its members. He said it was important to learn from Dr Mahathir's thinking and pass it on to future generations. The exhibition featuring photographs and posters on Vision 2020 is located at the fourth floor of Gerakan's headquarters in Menara PGRM, in Kuala Lumpur.
