Malaysia's first interior design centre launched

NEED help to solve interior design problems? Come to IDC, or Interior Design Centre, on the third floor of the MINES Shopping Fair in Seri Kembangan, Selangor.

Said to be Malaysia's first such design centre, the IDC was recently launched by MINES Resort City founder and managing director Tan Sri Lee Kim Yew (picture above).

Lee said: "IDC will have renowned interior design houses under one roof in an exhibition-style concept. With the standard of living increased, people are looking for a better and more luxurious lifestyle. IDC is expected to be the first choice for them when shopping for items for their house."

IDC will initially host between 45 and 55 design companies where the latest design and decor trends, both residential and commercial, will be showcased.

Homeowners can choose their preferred designers at the centre or shop for their needs there.

"The idea for the IDC was mooted by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad," said Lee.

An ice skating rink and a bowling alley will also be built at the centre.

The IDC will be a stone's throw away from the MINES International Exhibition and Convention Centre, where international trade exhibitions are often held.

Also nearby is the International Design Export Centre, which houses the largest furniture sourcing centre where export furniture can be obtained by the local market.
