MCA: Give scholarships to help Bumi students study at UTAR

KAMPAR, Fri. - The MCA hopes that the Federal Government will offer scholarships to Bumiputera students to get them to enrol in Universiti Tunku Abdul Rahman.

Party president Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik said this would be one of the ways to attract non-Chinese students to study at the university. MCA would submit a proposal to the Government soon on the matter.

He also said UTAR would not impose a quota on student admission.

"UTAR is for everyone," he told reporters after chairing a meeting on the forthcoming ground-breaking ceremony at Kolej TAR here yesterday.

The campus, which would be built next to Kolej TAR Perak, can accommodate 15,000 students. Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad is expected to perform the ground-breaking ceremony of the main campus this Sunday.
