RM353,718 raised for International Peace Fund

KUALA LUMPUR, Fri. - The Malaysian International Peace Fund has received a total of RM353,718.34 as of today.

During a Press conference, Malaysian Youth Council vice-president Loka Ng said the council would be organising the "MYC Charity Sale" to be held on May 12 at the Selangor Youth and Cultural Complex, Shah Alam from 6pm to 10pm to raise more funds for this worthy cause.

"Garments for children and adults will be available at rock bottom prices," he said.

He also said the total amount collected so far had exceeded the RM350,000 mark.

"The MYC raised the funds from the public and also youth organisations," Ng said.

"The donations will be presented to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on the National Youth Day celebrations on May 15 at the Bukit Jalil Putra Stadium," said Ng.

Also present at the Press conference was MYC secretary-general Norizan Sharif.
