#### Special treat for Langkawi residents

IN recognition of their generosity and hard work, residents of Langkawi are in for a treat during this year's Langkawi International Maritime and Aerospace exhibition.

Defence Ministry deputy secretary-general Datuk Siti Azizan Abood said recently a gathering would be held for the first time since the exhibition's inception in 1991.

She said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and other Government officials would attend the gathering on Friday.

Ninety-five of those invited have confirmed that they would be present or would send a representative while 60 will not be attending. The remaining number have yet to confirm either way.

The Royal Malaysian Air Force will provide VIP shuttle service from the Subang air base for visiting dignitaries from the armed forces, police and customs chiefs.

Siti said both the maritime and aerospace segments of Lima would see several signings of memoranda of understanding, letters of intent and letters of agreements.
