Struggle for Malay dominance not over yet, warns Khir

SELANGOR Umno liaison chief Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Khir Toyo said the party's struggle for Malay dominance in this country is not over yet.

He said even the president, with his farsightedness, had expressed his doubts about the future of the Malays, that if Malays continued with their lackadaisical attitude Vision 2020 would never be realised.

"Our challenge in this decade is to increase and enhance our knowledge in all aspects, especially in information communications and technology."

Debating the motion of thanks for the presidential address, Dr Mohd Khir said in this age, education and ICT were the weapons of war of developed nations.

He said if Malays could not rise to this challenge and improve on their quality of education they would be left far behind.
