TD2000 rolls into Africa

MALAYSIA'S hand-built TD2000 roadsters may soon be roaming the highways and byways of Southern Africa.

Brecca Enterprises director Enock Kamushinda said he "fell in love" with the TD2000 when he first saw it some three years ago.

"The TD2000 Roadster was driven by Malaysia's former PM, Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad, en route to The Langkawi International Dialogue (LID 2000). I decided there and then that I had to bring this magnificent sports car to southern Africa," he said after signing an MOU with TD Cars (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd managing director Edward Teo.

The MOU is for the sale and distribution of the sport car in Zimbabwe and in nine other African countries.

Teo also disclosed that TD Cars had earlier signed a distributorship agreement with a Kuwait company, Al-Kateefi Trading Co WLL, that would further enhance exports to the African continent.

"The elegant TD2000 will be unveiled by Malaysia's chief diplomatic representatives at two prestigious motor shows in Kuwait and Dubai this month and next month," Teo said.

The TD2000 classic sports car is assembled at Automotive Conversion Engineering Sdn Bhd, an EON Berhad subsidiary.
