Terengganu Sultan, PM head awards list

KLANG, Fri. - Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin of Terengganu and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad head the list of 83 people who will receive awards in conjunction with the coronation of Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah of Selangor tomorrow.

Both will receive the Darjah Kerabat Yang Amat Dihormati (DK I) at the investiture ceremony at Istana Alam Shah on March 17.

The Sultan's brother, Tengku Panglima di-Raja Selangor Tengku Sulaiman Shah, will receive the Darjah Kerabat Yang Amat Dihormati (DK II).

Chief Secretary to the Government Tan Sri Samsudin Osman will be awarded the Seri Paduka Mahkota Selangor (SPMS) award, which carries the title Datuk Seri.

Sultan Sharafuddin's daughter, Tengku Zerafina, will receive the Dato' Setia Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah (SSIS) award, which carries the title Datin Paduka Setia.

Twenty-four people will be made Datuks, 10 receiving the Dato' Paduka Mahkota Selangor (DPMS) while the rest will receive the Dato' Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah (DSIS). Both awards carry the title Datuk for men and Datin Paduka for women.

Those who will receive the DPMS are Ampang Jaya municipal councillor Ahmad Bujang, TV3 senior general manager (news and current affairs) Datuk Chamil Wariya, Kuala Lumpur police chief Datuk Dell Akbar Hyder Khan, Selangor police chief Datuk Mohd Noor Hamat and Royal Malaysian Navy deputy chief Laksamana Madya Datuk Mohd Anwar Mohd Nor.

Others are Technology Resources Industries Bhd director Lim Kheng Guan, Universiti Malaya Medical Centre director Professor Dr Mohd Amin Jalaludin, Konsortium Abbas chief executive officer Datuk Sulaiman Abu Bakar, Wisma Putra Under Secretary for Americas Division S. Thanarajasingam and Selangor State Development Corp (PKNS) deputy general manager Zainudin Zainal Abidin.

State Public Works Department director Abd Rashid Yusof heads the list of those receiving the DSIS. The others are Kumpulan Jatson Bhd public relations manager Dr Mohd Kassim Ali, Kojadi chairman Datuk Francis Chang-Hsun Huang, Malaysian Examination Council chief executive Termuzi Abdul Aziz, Worldwide Holdings Bhd managing director Ibrahim Md Yusof and KFC Holdings (M) Bhd managing director Johari Abdul Ghani.

Federation of Selangor and Kuala Lumpur Chinese Assembly Hall president Liew Poon Siak will receive the DSIS with Klang municipal council president Mohd Sharif Yusof, Universiti Putra Malaysia's Professor Dr Mohamed Shariff Mohamed Din, Universiti Malaya's Professor Dr Mohd Razali Agus, Melium group chief executive officer Richard Alexander John Curtis, SP Setia Bhd executive director-cum-chief executive officer Voon Tin Yow, The Star Publications executive editor Datuk Wong Chun Wai and Orang Besar Daerah Kuala Langat Raja Uzair Tengku Zainon Rashid Shah.

Thirteen will receive the Setia Mahkota Selangor (SMS) award, including Utusan Malaysia's assistant editor Abdul Aziz Ishak, Perbadanan Urus Air Selangor operations general manager V. Subramaniam and Kuala Selangor police chief Mohd Azmir Mohd Nadzri.

Eleven will receive the Setia Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah (SIS) award, including Subang Jaya municipal council deputy president Arpah Abdul Razak and People's Progressive Party Selangor vice-chairman D. Gnanasambantham.

Another 15 will receive the Ahli Mahkota Selangor (AMS) award including

Kuala Langat police chief Supt Abdul Malek Harun.

The Malay Mail news editor Lee Boon Siew leads the 12 who will receive the Ahli Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah (AIS). Others are special officer to the Selangor Sultan, Adnan Abdullah, and The Star Klang bureau journalist Elantiraian Perumal.

Two others will receive the Bintang Perkhidmatan Cemerlang.
