Pahang MB thinking of reshuffling Umno committee

KUANTAN, Mon. - Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Adnan Yaakob said today a reshuffle of the Pahang Umno liaison committee is inevitable if it means helping to strengthen the party to face the general election.

Adnan, who is State Umno chairman, said he was considering a reshuffle of the State party leadership.

"It's something which may be discussed at the State liaison committee meeting next month (Feb 13 and 14). Whether we will go ahead will be known soon, give me some time," he said after a get-together organised by the Pahang Skill Development Centre in Semambu, near here.

He was asked on the move by several States including Perlis, Perak, Terengganu and Malacca, to change their line-ups in preparation for the election.

Last Thursday, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad announced a major reshuffle of the Kelantan Umno set-up to prepare for the general election.

Asked if he was satisfied with the line-up in the State party committee, Adnan replied: "We can never be satisfied with everything."

"We need to go down to the ground more often and explain that we are the better choice."

Commenting on Perak Assemblymen who were willing to give way for others, he said the same was unlikely to happen in Pahang.
