SINCE HIS CHILDHOOD, DATUK SERI DR. MAHATHIR MOHAMAD HAS DISPLAYED DISTINCT CHARACTER, UPHOLDING THE PHILOSOPHY THAT WHATEVER OTHERS CAN DO, HE CAN DO TOO. FROM A VERY YOUNG AGE, DR. MAHATHIR HAS ALSO PROVED TO BE CONSCIENTIOUS AND INTELLIGENT.

HIS FIRST BUSINESS VENTURE WAS A COFFEE AND OAKES STALL SHARED WITH TWO CLOSE FRIENDS, ENCIK JOHARI MOHAMAD TAIB (PAK JO) AND ENCIK NOOR MADAR (NANA).

THE STALL WAS LOCATED BESIDE THE RIVER AT PEKAN RABU, THE SITE IS NOW THE KOTA SETAR LAND OFFICE CAR PARK.

ACCORDING TO PAK JO, WHO NOW RUNS HIS OWN STALL AT PEKAN RABU, DATUK SERI DR. MAHATHIR WAS A CONSCIENTIOUS SCHOLAR.

+CHE DET (MAHATHIR) WAS N NEVER WITHOUT A BOOK. WHENEVER THERE WAS NOTHING TO BE DONE, HE WOULD BE READING, + ASSERTS PAK JO.

NOW 63 YEARS OLD, PAK JO DESCRIBES DR. MAHATHIR AS A FIRM, HONEST AND FORTHRIGHT MAN.

SUBSEQUENTLY, DR. MAHATHIR AND HIS TWO BUSINESS ASSOCIATES SET UP A STALL TO SELL FRUITS AND HANDICRAFTS AT PEKAN RABU.

DR. MAHATHIR'S BUSINESS VENTURES CAME TO AN END WHEN THE SECOND WORLD WAR TERMINATED AND MALAYA WAS RETURNED TO BRITISH RULE.

DR. MAHATHIR RESUMED HIS STUDIES IN THE GOVERNMENT ENGLISH SCHOOL IN 1945 UNTIL HE OBTAINED HIS SENIOR CAMBRIDGE CERTIFICATE.

IN 1948, DR. MAHATHIR FURTHERED HIS EDUCATION IN MEDICINE IN RAFFLES COLLEGE, SINGAPORE.

DR. MAHATHIR JOINED THE GOVERNMENT SERVICE IN 1954 AND SERVED AT THE ALOR STAR HOSPITAL. IN 1956, DR. MAHATHIR SERVED AS MEDICAL OFFICER AT LANGKAWI FOR SIX MONTHS BEFORE RESUMING HIS SERVICE AT THE ALOR STAR HOSPITAL. — BERNAMA FEATURE MORE 0809/ZCM

MAHATHIR 5 (BERNAMA FEATURE)

IN 1957, DR. MAHATHIR RESIGNED FROM GOVERNMENT SERVICE TO OPEN HIS OWN CLINIC, MAHA KLINIK, ON JALAN TUNKU IBRAHIM.

ACCORDING TO ENCIK ABDULLAH BIN PA' CHIK OR PAK LAH, AGED 64 YEARS, WHO HAS BEEN WITH THE MAHA KLINIK SINCE ITS ESTABLISHMENT, DR. MAHATHIR IS ALSO A GENEROUS MAN.

DR. MAHATHIR DID NOT MAKE HIS PATIENTS PAY FOR THEIR TREATMENT IF THEY WERE TOO POOR.

PAK LAH ALSO SAYS THAT IF THE PATIENT DID NOT HAVE SUFFICIENT MONEY TO PAY, DR. MAHATHIR WOULD JUST ACCEPT A TOKEN PAYMENT OF 10 SEN, 50 SEN OR ONE RINGGIT.

ACCORDING TO PAK LAH, THERE WERE ONLY FIVE MEDICAL CLINICS IN ALOR STAR IN 1957 AND MAHA KLINIK WAS THE FIRST TO BE SET UP BY A MALAY DOCTOR. — BERNAMA FEATURE MORE 0812/ZCM

MAHATHIR 6 (BERNAMA FEATURE)

MAHA KLINIK BECAME THE MEETING PLACE OF THE PEOPLE, PARTICULARLY MALAYS FROM ALOR STAR AND THE NEARBY TOWNS.

THE CLINIC WAS SHIFTED TO PEKAN MELAYU IN 1959 TO MEET THE INCREASING DEMANDS MADE ON IT.

PAK LAH SAYS SINCE DR. MAHATHIR OPENED HIS CLINIC, HE HAS NEVER HANDLED THE CASH TAKINGS WHICH WERE FIRST IN THE HANDS OF HIS BROTHER-IN-LAW, THE LATE PAK HASSAN, AND SUBSEQUENTLY PAK LAH HIMSELF.
