CALLING FOR PM'S QUALITY AWARD NOMINATIONS

KUALA LUMPUR, April 5 (Bernama) -- The public, private and socio-economic sectors are invited to submit entries for the annual Prime Minister's Quality Award which was introduced in 1990.

Chief Secretary to the Government Tan Sri Ahmad Sarji Abdul Hamid said today that the closing date for entries from the public sector is April 30 while that for the private and socio-economic categories is June 30.

Further information can be obtained from the award secretariat before the closing dates, he said in a statement.

He said the conferment of the award was an important government strategy to inculcate the interest and commitment of organisations towards practising excellent work culture.

Ahmad Sarji is Chairman of the Excellent Work Culture Movement Supreme Council, the body coordinating implementation of the award.

The public sector award is for ministries, departments and statutory bodies, the private sector award for businesses registered under the Companies Act and the socio-economic sector award for non-governmental organisations and voluntary bodies registered under the Societies Act. --
