ABDULLAH DESCRIBES TUN DR MAHATHIR AS A GREAT STATESMAN

PUTRAJAYA, Dec 19 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi has expressed his highest appreciation to his predecessor Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad for the latter's contributions which have enabled Malaysia to emerge as a successful nation, envied by others on the international scene.
