

Uchapan Y.B. Inche Hussein Onn,

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Terlebeh dahulu saya ingin menguchapkan  
selamat datang kepada tetamu2 dan puan2 sekalian  
ka-Kejohanan Drama Sekolah2 Menengah ini. Kejohanan  
ini di-adakan bersempena dengan Expo Pendidikan '72.  
Tujuan2-nya ia-lah untok memberi galakan serta  
menimbulkan minat di-kalangan sekolah2 kita ter-  
hadap drama; mengasah bakat2 berlakun; memperkembangkan  
minat di-kalangan kanak2 kita terhadap seni; menggalak-  
kan penulis2 kita supaya menerbitkan lebeh banyak  
lakunan yang baik dan mementaskan-nya serta  
menimbulkan minat di-kalangan kanak2 kita terhadap  
kesusasteraan.

2. Sebanyak sebelas buah negeri di-Malaysia Barat mengambil bahagian dalam Kejohanan Kebangsaan ini dimana tiap2 negeri menghantar pasukan johan sekolahnya. Y.A.B. Perdana Menteri kita telah bermurah hati mendermakan sa-buah piala pusingan dan di-harap kejohanan ini akan di-adakan dari masa ka-semasa.

3. Para peserta boleh-lah memilih salah satu daripada empat lakunan, ia-itu, Serunai Malam (Night Flute) oleh Inche Usman Awang, Kereta Emas (Golden Car) oleh Inche Lee Joo For, Malam Perhitungan (Night of The Reckoning) oleh Inche Kemala dan Durian Runtuh menjelang Suboh (Durian Falls at Dawn) oleh Inche Alias Idris. Walau bagaimana pun, dua lakunan

sahaja telah di-pileh, ia-itu Malam Perhitungan dan Serunai Malam. Saya di-fahamkan bahawa ini adalah di-sebabkan oleh daya penarek-nya dari segi drama dan memerlukan kebolehan lakunan yang sebaik2-nya, dan menggambarkan kehidupan serta chita2 kaum belia kita. Pada malam ini ada dua pasokan yang mengambil bahagian. Satu pasokan merupakan lakunan pasokan *iaitu Sekolah Menengah Zamiah, Kota Bharu* johan/ dan satu lagi dari pasokan terbaik dalam kejohanan lakunan yang tiada menjadi johan, *iaitu Sekolah Menengah Sultan Sulaiman, Kuala Terengganu.*

Speech of Enche Hussein Omar,  
Minister of Education, at The  
Secondary Schools Drama Championships  
held at the City Hall, Kuala Lumpur,

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1. First of all, I wish to welcome our distinguished and other guests to our Secondary Schools Drama ~~Championship~~ <sup>Championships</sup>. The Championship is held in conjunction with the Education Expo. Its objects are to encourage and interest our schools in literary plays; to improve acting talents; to ~~develop~~ <sup>develop</sup> interests in our children towards fine arts; to encourage our writers to produce ~~and~~ more and better plays and to stage them, and to interest our children in literature.

2. Eleven States in West Malaysia take national part in this Championship, each State sending its champion school team. Our Prime Minister has very kindly donated a challenge cup and it is hoped that the Championships will be held from time to time.

The participants can choose one of four selected plays, that is, Serunai malam (Night Flute) by Inche ~~Ellsman~~ Awang, Kereta Emas (Golden Car) by Inche Lee Joo ~~For~~ For, malam Perhitungan <sup>of the</sup> ~~of the~~ Reckoning) by Inche ~~Kamata~~ <sup>Kemala</sup> and Durian runtuk menjelang Subuh (Durian Falls At Dawn) by Inche Alias Idris.
