A Message from Our CG

Loud, unapologetic, and unprecedentedly challenging are just some of the few words one can use to describe the year 2020. With the rampant spread of the novel Corona virus in China in the beginning of the year, quite a few of us here had foreseen that it was just a matter of time before the outbreak would evolve into something more threatening, considering how people were traveling in and out of Wuhan to other parts of China and all around the world to celebrate the lunar new year.

During the peak of infection, the city of Nanning was transformed into an eerie ghost town (the wintry dark sky had heightened the effect). Save for some essential services, offices and shops were close, the normally busy roads and lively parks were abandoned, while malls and recreational establishments were sealed tight. At a glance, it was no different than the typical zombie-infested, post-apocalyptic run-of-the-mill Hollywood movies. The more melodramatic city dwellers had hogged all of the groceries to stock their homes - toilet paper included.

Addressing the above, the Consulate General of Malaysia in Nanning had remained steadfast and committed to serve while flying our flag high. We had successfully assisted Malaysians stranded in both Guangxi and Guizhou to find a safe passage to return home as transportations and movements were severely restricted. I have to admit that it was not an easy feat as we had to communicate and coordinate with the local authorities from each village, county, and city concerned to provide ways for our fellow Malaysians to return home.

At the same time, the kindness and thoughtfulness of the local government agencies and private companies did not go unacknowledged in donating medical items to Malaysia. We had painstakingly done our best to ensure that all donations were smoothly channeled back to Malaysia. Though these did not go without the accompanying obstacles including stringent shipment procedures, understandably imposed in order to contain further spread of the pandemic.

All of these were executed when the city was under partial lockdown and fear of infection was at its peak, almost to the point of paranoia to some.

Despite the challenges and inconvenience, the situation had turned out to become a testament of the spirit of solidarity, togetherness, and friendship among those residing here. When the Consulate's commitment to serve was stretched and tested, the cooperation given by Malaysians here and the assistance rendered by the local authorities had greatly eased the ordeal. Without the positivity of all parties involved, the situation could certainly spiral down even further.

Taking the above into account, I would like to extend my sincerest and deepest appreciation to Malaysians who had given their unwavering support and cooperation during this time of difficulty. Special note should also be extended to the governments and authorities of the Autonomous Region of Guangxi, as well as the Province of Guizhou for the generosity, assistance, and understanding in ensuring the smooth operation and functioning of the Consulate. And of course, kudos too to my colleagues for their dedication, professionalism, and sense of responsibility that they had proven including burning buckets of their midnight oil.

With this, I am confident that the spirit of solidarity, togetherness, and friendship displayed during the crisis will continue to flourish and lead the way forward for the future relation between us all.

Authentication Process for Chinese Documents for use in Malaysia

1. Description of Application:

The Authentication process is often referred to as **Document Attestation** by which the documents issued by foreign countries to be used in Malaysia shall first be notarized and legalized by the competent authorities in that country, and then be legalized by the Malaysian Embassy or Consulates in that country.

Generally, documents required for legalization are as follows: birth, death, marriage, no criminal record, kinship, academic qualification, professional qualification, declaration, entrustment paper, power of attorney, contract, articles of association, certification of inspection and quarantine of animals or plants, certificate of origin, invoice, and other notarial certificates, certifications or notes for civil or business purposes etc.

2. Terms and Procedure of Application:

In general, the process involves three (3) steps as follows:

Step One:

All Chinese documents shall be translated into English by the notary public office;

Step Two:

Send the notarization to the local Foreign Affairs Office (FAO, 外办) or one of the agencies authorized by the Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA, 中国外交部) to get your document authenticated. Step Three:

Bring your authenticated document to the Consulate General office for an additional authentication of the FAO official's signature.

3. Required Documents:

Original documents and 1 copy of the document(s) that need authentication.

Note: All copies should be made on A4 paper.

4. Payment:

CNY 50.00 per signature

5. Processing Period:

Three (3) working days after submission of complete documents.

MEETING WITH CHINA-ASEAN EXPO (CAEXPO) SECRETARIAT

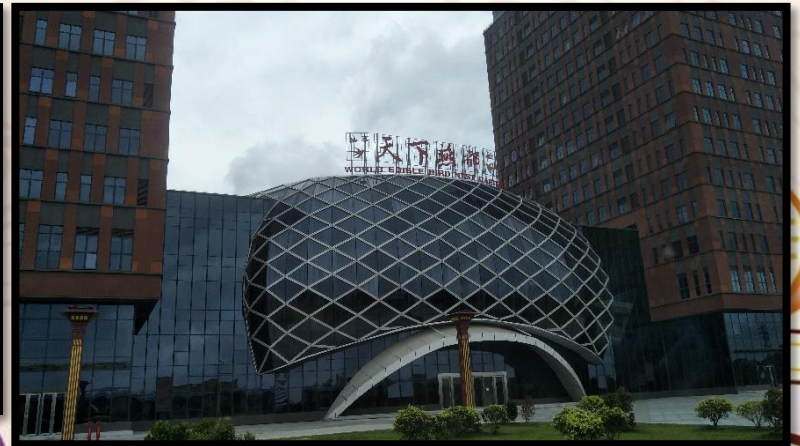

CONSUL-GENERAL WORKING VISIT TO CHINA-MALAYSIA QINZHOU INDUSTRIAL PARK



Qinzhou, 10 June 2020 – Dr Rodger Wong, the new Executive Deputy Director-General of China-Malaysia Qinzhou Industrial Park (CMQIP) Administrative Committee received the Consul-General of Malaysia and the new Investment Consul of the Consulate General of Malaysia in Guangzhou, Mr. Muhammad Sawadde. The CG congratulated Dr. Rodger on his appointment as the new Executive DDG of CMQIP, while discussing matters relating to the twin parks.



The visit marked the fourth visit of the Consul-General to CMQIP since his arrival 2019, thus further attesting Malaysia's seriousness in the twin parks initiative. Upon his introduction, the Investment Consul shared his views as well as facts and figures on the growing Malaysia-China relations in the investment sector. He also added that China had remained as Malaysia's biggest foreign investor for four consecutive years and MIDA's commitment to further promote cooperation by taking full advantage of the twin ports in Kuantan and Qinzhou.

RESPONSE BY CGM NANNING TO COVID-19

The Consulate-General of Malaysia in Nanning had received and managed the delivery of donations from several local agencies in the wake of the spread of COVID-19. Among the kind contributors that had reached the CGM were Guangxi FAO, Nanning FAO, CAEXPO Secretariat, and several private companies. MISSION'S UPDATE CONCERNING THE CORONAVIRUS IN CHINA (AS OF 4 FEBRUARY 2020)

With regard to the rising number of confirmed cases of the novel coronavirus 2019-nCoV in China, the Consulate-General of Malaysia in Nanning would like to once again advise all Malaysians residing in Guangxi and Guizhou to update us on their current whereabouts. We would also like to take this opportunity to remind those who have yet to register with the Consulate to do so immediately. As such, the Consulate will not be held liable for the obstruction of information flow to those who fail to take either of the actions as mentioned above.

Preventative and control efforts have been implemented by the governments of Guangxi and Guizhou. In view of this, Malaysians are advised to take the following actions:

- (i) Please stay calm and follow the local health screening regulations;
- (ii) Follow the official accounts of provincial FACs (Guangxi ID: gwxqzw, Guizhou ID: gh_4e08862122a) for updates and necessary assistance;
- (iii) Follow the official accounts of the local Exit and Entry Bureaus (Nanning ID: nngazt, Guiyang ID: gycgcpf) and the National Immigration Administration Office (ID: MIANEWS) to get the updated information on disease prevention and control;
- (iv) Due to the current situation, consular assistance will be constrained. However should there be a need for such assistance, please contact the Consulate General of Malaysia at (Tel: 0771-5662562; Mob:159 7778 3818; Email: mwnanning@mfn.gov.my);
- (v) Practice good hygiene as advised by the government and avoid unnecessary outdoor activities; and
- (vi) Many airline companies have reduced or cancelled their flights. Those affected can rearrange their flight schedule by contacting their airline operators directly.

The Consulate would like to thank Malaysians who have cooperated with us. As such, we urge those who have not registered and updated us on their current whereabouts to do so immediately. Your well-being is our utmost concern.

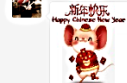

MISSION'S UPDATE ON THE PREVENTION AND CONTROL MEASURES OVER COVID-19 IN GUANGXI AND GUIZHOU (As of 19 March 2020)

Starting from 17 March 2020, Guangxi and Guizhou will quarantine all travellers from overseas, including Chinese citizens, at designated locations for 14 days in both the land and air ports. And inbound travellers need to pay for the 14-day quarantine expenses themselves.

In this context, Consulate General of Malaysia in Nanning suggests Malaysians to avoid any non-essential traveling into Guangxi and Guizhou during the outbreak, the major concerns are as below:

- i. It would increase the risk of infections and bring more challenges for the pandemic control;
- ii. 14-day quarantine at designated locations is mandatory in Guangxi and Guizhou and the travellers need to bear the expenses themselves;
- iii. Inbound travellers diagnosed with the new coronavirus after entering Guangxi and Guizhou will have to pay for treatment if they are not covered by either the country's medical insurance or commercial insurance;
- iv. Entry restriction measures in different provinces/cities are subject to be changed from time to time which might affect the traveller's schedules or movement.

Reminder:

- i. Travellers to China are advised to make health declaration report truthfully, the local government would investigate anyone caught lying about their symptoms, concealing their illness or travel history. Those caught with false information will be severely reprimanded;
- ii. According to the Exit and Entry Administration Law of the People's Republic of China, for foreigners who reside or stay in dwelling places other than hotels, stay at the premises who accommodate them shall, within 24 hours after the foreigners' arrival at that dwelling place, go through the registration formalities with the public security authorities in the place of residence.
