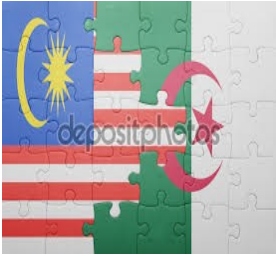

ment and current development.



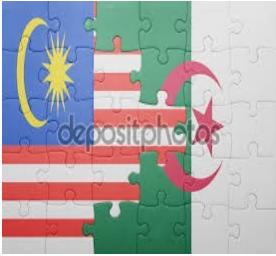

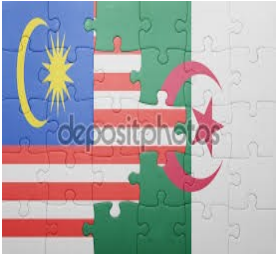
