- Basic Metal Products;
- Rubber Products; and
- Plastic Products

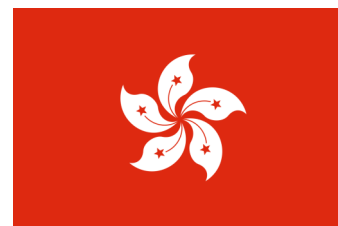
ASEAN - Hong Kong FTA (AHKFTA)

The negotiations for AHKFTA started in 2015 and are expected to be concluded in 2016. Hong Kong is keen to deepen and broaden its involvement in the economic development of Southeast Asia. Hong Kong SAR's trade with ASEAN has seen a steady growth of 10% per annum from 2009 to 2014. ASEAN is Hong Kong SAR's second largest trading partner in terms of goods, fourth largest partner in terms of services, fifth largest destination for foreign direct investment from Hong Kong SAR, and sixth largest source of FDI into Hong Kong.

The first round of negotiation on the Free Trade Agreement (FTA) between Hong Kong SAR and ASEAN was

held successfully on 11 July 2014. The AHKFTA Trade Negotiating Committee (TNC) has met six times.

Three meetings have been scheduled for 2016. The next will be 8th ASEAN-Hong Kong Trade Negotiating Committee Meeting (AHKTNC), which will be held from 22 until 26 August 2016 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.



Belt and Road Summit

Belt and Road Summit was held in Hong Kong on 18 May 2016 to explore business opportunities presented to the world by the Belt and Road Initiative. Mr. Zhang Dejiang, the Member of the Standing

Committee of the Political Bureau of the Communist Party of China Central Committee and Chairman of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress of the PRC delivered a keynote speech.

The Second Minister of International Trade and Industry, H.E. Ong Ka Chuan, was one of the speaker at the inaugural Belt and Road Summit in May 2016.

Consul General in Residence Lecture Series 2016

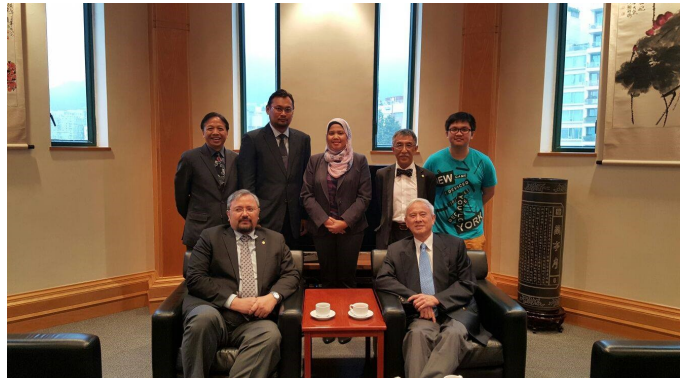

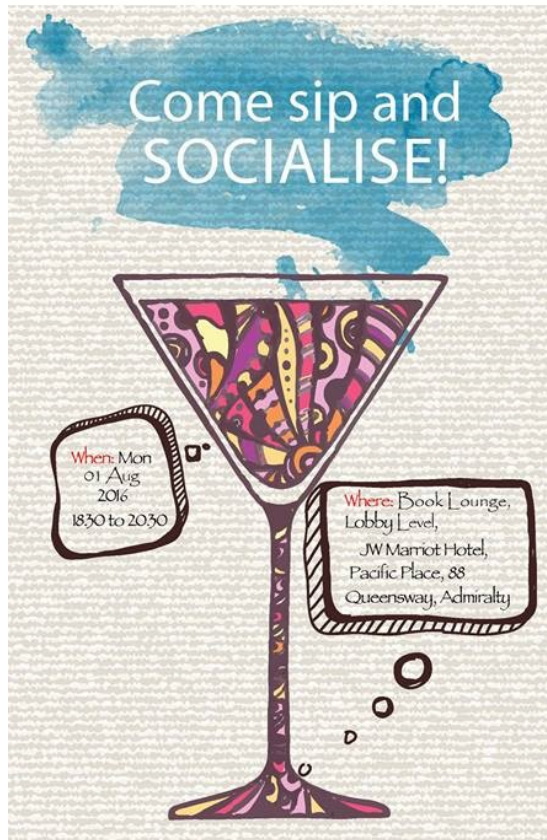

The Consulate General of Malaysia in Hong Kong has been in existence since 2 July 1971. It was known as the Commission of Malaysia before the establishment of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (SAR). Previously, the office was housed at 25th Floor of Comfort Building, Connaught Road. On 2 June 1980, the office moved to the current location at 50 Gloucester Road, Wanchai after the Malaysian Government acquired its own building.

Besides the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia, there are other Government Agencies operating under the Consulate namely, the Immigration Department of Malaysia, Malaysia Tourism Promotion Board and Malaysia External Trade Development Corporation (MATRADE).
