

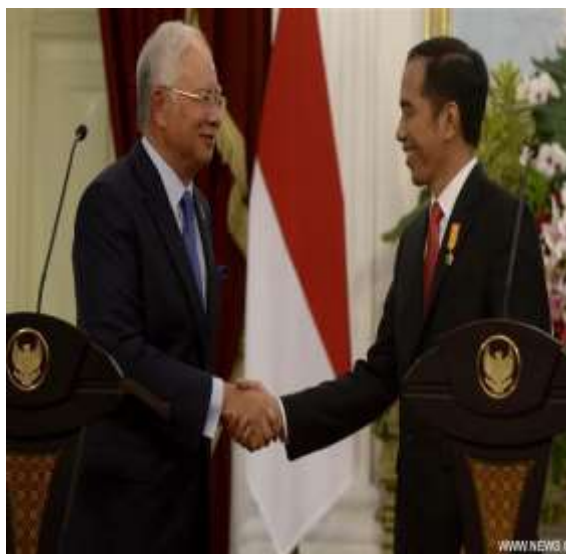

## WORKING VISIT OF YAB DATO' SRI MOHD. NAJIB TUN ABDUL RAZAK, PRIME MINISTER OF MALAYSIA TO JAKARTA, 1 - 3 AUGUST 2016

YAB Dato' Sri Mohd Najib Tun Razak undertook a working visit to Jakarta, Republic of Indonesia on 1 to 3 August 2016. The visit is in conjunction with the 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Consultation between the Prime Minister of Malaysia and the President of the Republic of Indonesia and the 12<sup>th</sup> World Islamic Economic Forum.

Taking place in Jakarta, the 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Consultation between leaders of Malaysia and Indonesia, YAB Dato' Sri Najib Tun Razak and Bapak Joko Widodo (Jokowi) attended the meeting for the first time under the Annual Consultation framework. Both leaders also witnessed the signing of the Bilateral Agreement between Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) and Otoritas Jaksa Keuangan (OJK) under the ASEAN Banking Intergration Framework.
